This letter is to confirm that Goldcorp Inc. has been in discussions with officials from UBC and SFU with respect to our participation as a strategic partner for the Canadian International Institute for Extractive Industries and Development (CIIEID).

Goldcorp Inc. is interested in supporting and participating within the Canadian International Institute for Extractive Industries and Development (CIIEID) in the following manner:

- Given that Goldcorp is a multinational gold mining company operating mainly in the Americas (North, Central and South), our projects and experience are expected to contribute greatly to the priority of the Canadian International Institute for Extractive Industries and Development (CIIEID).
- Our company does extensive work in the areas of Corporate Social Responsibility around all of our mining operations and the types of projects that have been identified with both academic institutions (UBC and SFU) can contribute greatly to the building of capacity in the communities and countries where our mining projects have the potential of having a significant impact.
- Goldcorp's previous participation within constructive dialogue series at SFU can be further enhanced within the Canadian International Institute for Extractive Industries and Development (CIIEID) by furthering our efforts in creating a process within which extractive companies can enhance their consultative process with many stakeholders.
- Given that approximately 50% of our operations are located in Canada, Goldcorp has the ability to leverage our Canadian experience in terms of operations, CSR, community outreach and consultations in order to "export" this experience in countries and areas where capacity is required.
- As many of Goldcorp's operations are located in developing countries, the company will be able to provide our projects as a site for further research, analysis and development work.
- The countries where Goldcorp would concentrate our efforts in providing test sites for the Canadian International Institute for Extractive Industries and Development (CIIEID) projects would be: Guatemala, Honduras, Chile, Argentina, Dominican Republic. While also making use of our extensive experience in Canada, United States and also Mexico.
- Goldcorp's work surrounding water issues and initiatives could be further advanced as this becomes a major topic for discussion and for our operations over the upcoming decades.


